### Document Checklist – PAP

1. PAP application form
2. Application for qualification as geriatric nurse for the ministry of health
3. Secondary Schooling or equivalent (both: front and back page)
4. If existent: Higher Secondary or equivalent (both: front and back page)
5. Professional qualification certificate
6. Curricular of the professional qualification
7. If existent: consolidated mark sheets from the university or college (if coursework completed)
8. If existent: Individual Semester wise mark sheets
9. If existent: Provisional certificate (Note: we do not accept the course completion certificate as an equivalent)
10. Degree certificate (if applicable)
11. Photocopy of passport (front and back page)
12. Extra-curricular activity certificates (if any)
13. German language certificates (if any)
14. Professional passportsize photograph with good resolution (as JPEG, Gif, PNG, Tiff-titled)
15. Work experience certificates (if any)

### How to Apply

1. Complete the application form and send across the required documents, wait for our International office /ministry of health to verify/proof your documents (3 to 4 Weeks)
2. When accepted students receive admission acceptance form. It has to be signed and sent back to IAS via email as a scanned copy (1 to 2 weeks)
3. Transfer Fees
4. Skype-interview
5. Original admission letter via email
6. Open Blocked Bank account in Germany
7. Apply for Visa
8. Once Visa issued, Pack your bags to fly to Germany

## PAP - Overview

PAP is a one year recognition program especially designed for international nursing / healthcare professionals.

This program prepares candidates in German language, profession oriented curriculum, Geriatric practical training & inter-cultural competence. The curriculum is coordinated with the German ministry of health and social affairs.

The participants will receive German recognition as a senior care nurse after successful completion of the coursework. Candidates of PAP program reach the equivalence of German geriatric nurses & receive the licensing to work throughout Germany.

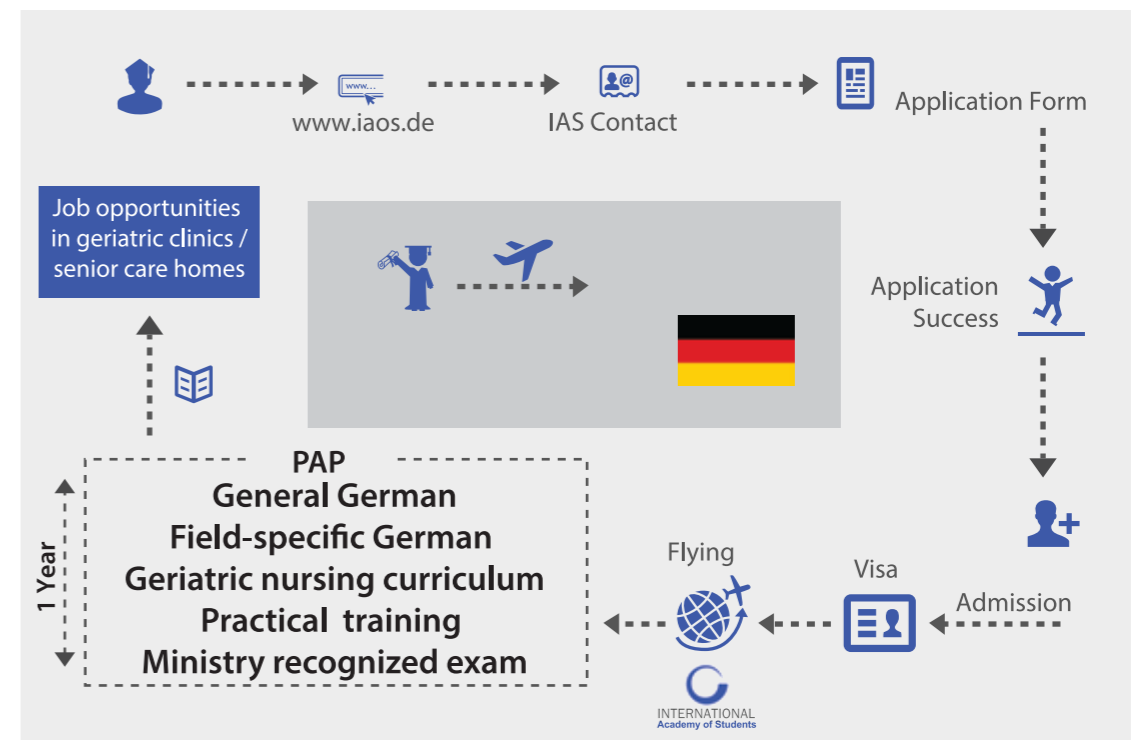
